Student Scholarship Program

A little goes a long way...

The cost of an entire year of tuition for Christian education in Indonesia varies depending on the location. The current average annual tuition is \$79.

This small investment has the potential to have a significant impact on the future of the students and their family.

Scholarship Award Process

- Schools are selected by the PKKA
- The principals of the schools provide a list of needy students.
- Scholarships are awarded based purely on need regardless of their religion or ethnic background.
- Scholarships can be renewed based on the students' academic achievement until they graduate.

Program Highlights

In 2007, the first year of the Student Scholarship Program, 12 students received scholarships to continue their education. After 17 years in operation, PKKA has been able to fund over 2,000 scholarships. The students were from elementary, junior high, high school, and vocational schools.

When asked what they hoped to be or accomplish with their education, the students' goals included:

- helping their parents
- becoming a teacher, nurse, doctor, and government officials
- · entering the priesthood

- Papua
- South Celebes

Focus of the PKKA

EDUCATION: Support for students in Indonesia who want to attend school, but do not have the resources.

INCLUSIVITY: Scholarships are provided to Christian and non Christian students who attend Christian schools in Indonesia.

RELATIONSHIP: Funds are provided to individual students, allowing PKKA to track the specific impact of donations on students' progress.

ACCOUNTABILITY: 94% of donations are directed to scholarships, which can only be used for tuition. The other 6% are used for postage, accounting, and bank fees. Funds are delivered directly to the students through school principals or administrators by PKKA's representative in Indonesia.

PKKA seeks to demonstrate Christ's love for all by supporting the education and future of those in need regardless of their religion or ethnic background.
